Course Evaluation:

#### Appeals Process:

The teacher will not have prior knowledge of the student's previous grade for the given assignment. If there is still an issue, a meeting will be set up between the student, teacher, parents, and administration to resolve the matter. The commencement of an appeal must occur in a timely manner, within 48 hours of receiving the marked assignment. In return, the appeal process will be completed as soon as possible.
