

# Mayerthorpe Legion 126 Poppy Fund Bursary Information



#### General Information:

Poppy Funds are made available through the generosity of the Mayerthorpe community and are part of the public trust between Canadians and the Legion.

Annual bursaries are available to students continuing on to post-secondary education who are direct descendants (child, grandchild, great-grandchild) of veterans who served in the following capacity:

- 1. Any person who is serving or who has honourably served in the Canadian Forces and their dependants who are in need of assistance;
- 2. Merchant Navy personnel who are eligible for and who have been awarded campaign stars or decorations, and their dependants who are in need of assistance;
- 3. Ex-service personnel of Commonwealth countries who are resident in Canada, and their dependants who are in need of assistance; and
- 4. Ex-service personnel of allied countries who are resident in Canada, and their dependants who are in need of assistance.

Students must be enrolled in the Mayerthorpe High School; or, if applying as a mature student, must have attended the Mayerthorpe High School.

#### The Bursary:

All eligible applicants will receive support. The disbursement of the funds is dependent on the number of successful applicants. Subsequent bursaries must be applied for annually during post-secondary training.

If there is only one applicant, the maximum award is \$500. The final amount awarded will depend on the number of applicants.

#### Criteria/Procedure for Applicants:

- The deadline for application is June 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. Applicants must be accepted into an accredited post-secondary program. The successful candidate(s) will be informed by September 30th and presented the award at the Mayerthorpe Legion Remembrance Day Services on November 11<sup>th</sup>.
- 2. Fill out application\* and mail to:

- 3. Acceptance into an accredited program qualifies the applicant for the bursary even if he/she does not have a Grade 12 Diploma (mature students).
- 4. Upon completion of the first year of study, a brief letter should be sent to the Mayerthorpe Legion informing the Legion of the student's performance.
