

## **Leon Aubrey Memorial Scholarship**

Leon Aubrey was born and raised in the Mayerthorpe area and attended and graduated from Mayerthorpe High School. He was a local farmer, business owner, tradesperson and family man. He was an avid outdoorsman who loved to share his passions with family and friends. He worked with his hands daily either working as a Millwright at ANC or rebuilding his pieces of heavy equipment, old cars and motorcycles.

The Leon Aubrey Memorial Scholarship has been set-up by his wife and daughter to support a student from Mayerthorpe Area or Mayerthorpe Jr/ Sr High School to attend further education in a trade or technical field.

### **The Scholarship**

This scholarship will be awarded to a student who demonstrates a financial need for support to attend their training. The scholarship is provided for the tuition and book costs only. The value will be directly dependent on the program tuition and book costs to a maximum of \$10,000 for the entire program. Applicants will be supported through the scholarship for their entire program to a maximum of four years. Tuition and books will be paid directly to the educational institute on a semester or yearly basis as the program requires.

### **Criteria for Eligibility and Application Requirements**

1. The application must be received at the school no later than April 18, 2019 by 4 p.m. Successful candidates will be informed in June.

  - a. The applicant's chosen field
  - b. The applicant's demonstrated financial need
  - c. The applicant's plan to complete their studies
  - d. The applicant's future goals and plans within their chosen field
4. Application must be accompanied by the following:
  - a. An essay outlining who Leon Aubrey was and how the applicant's character and goals fit the spirit of the award.
5. Students applying for this scholarship must meet the criteria of the following:
  - a. have attended and successfully completed at least one semester at MHS.
  - b. Applicant must be 20 years of age or younger as of September 1 of the post-secondary school year they apply for.
