

Jolene Hunt Memorial Bursary

Jolene Ann Hunt was born March 29, 1980 in Lethbridge, Alberta. When Jolene was young, her parents moved the family to the Whitecourt area where she attended St. Mary's Kindergarten. Shortly thereafter the family moved to Mayerthorpe. Jolene attended Elmer Elson Elementary from grade one to grade six. Junior and senior school years were attended at Mayerthorpe Jr. and Sr. High School. She graduated in May 1998 and then began her adult life in Whitecourt.

In September 2000, Jolene moved to Red Deer Alberta where she attended Red Deer College, taking Rehabilitation Services. She graduated in February 2002. After graduation she stayed in Red Deer and worked for COSMOS. Jolene loved her job working with adults. Her personality was one of the great attributes about Jolene that helped her find success in the field. The adults she worked with became not only her clients, but her most cherished friends. Jolene was excellent at her job. She poured all of her heart and soul into it. It wasn't just a job to her. She did many extra things to make people happy and feel special.

This is a bursary in memory of Jolene because of her personality and the loving person she was, not only in her ability to do her job, but also in the way she cared with all her heart for the family, friends and clients she left behind.

The Scholarship:

One **\$500** scholarship will be awarded annually to either a female or male graduate of Mayerthorpe High School who is accepted to attend an Alberta university or college in the Faculties of Social Work, Recreation Therapist, Nursing or Rehabilitation Medicine.

The bursary will be presented at the high school awards presentation or will be mailed directly to the recipients.
5. **Upon completion of their year of study, a brief letter should be forwarded by the student to the school office stating how the successful applicants did with their studies.**
