

# THE BLASKO FAMILY ARTS SCHOLARSHIP

Joseph Blasko was a tinsmith in Czecho-Slovakia. After having served in the Slovakian Army during the 1<sup>st</sup> World War, Joseph Blasko, his wife Agnesa and their two sons Stephen and Joseph Jr. came to Canada on October 15<sup>th</sup>, 1923. Three more sons were born after they came to Canada - Rudolf, who died at infancy, John and Ejnar.

The Blasko family would like to acknowledge and assist local area talent to pursue careers in the Arts Programs as they have been involved in various forms of art themselves. This is their way of “giving back” to their community, having lived here all of their lives.

## The Scholarship:

One **\$500** scholarship will be awarded annually to students from the geographic area covered by the **Sangudo, Blue Ridge and Mayerthorpe areas** that express a desire to continue their education in the arts. This may include the literary arts or performing arts including music, dance & drama, or the areas of creative arts (painting, sketching, graphics and photography).

## Criteria/Procedure for Scholarship Applicants

1. This award must be applied for no later than May 8. Successful candidates will be informed sometime prior to the end of June.

3. Acceptance into an accredited program qualifies the person for the bursary even if they **do not** have their grade 12 diploma. This program is also open to **young adult students**.
4. Acceptance of applicant will not necessarily be based strictly on school marks but whether or not the **talent** and **drive** of the student have been notably exhibited.
5. Presentation of the bursary will be made after the student is registered and attending classes. Proof of attendance at the post-secondary institution must be forwarded to the awards committee at MHS by Sept 30<sup>th</sup>. The bursary will be presented at the high school awards presentation or will be mailed directly to the recipients.
6. **Upon completion of their year of study, a brief letter should be forwarded by the student to the school office stating how the successful applicants did with their studies.**
