This Scholarship is available to members of the graduating High School classes of Whitecourt, Mayerthorpe, Fox Creek, Sangudo, and Fort Assiniboine

An Applicant must:

1. Have made application to and been accepted by a post-secondary or technical institute following graduation from high school.
2. Have shown involvement in school, church, or the community at large.
3. Have four(4) letters of reference, one from each of the following:
 - The school principal
 - a guidance counselor
 - a teacher
 - a businessperson in Whitecourt or Fox Creek or Mayerthorpe, or a non-related citizen character reference
4. Write an essay describing his/her future plans and why he/she would benefit from the Scholarship.
5. Submit a copy of your school marks.

One Bursary will be awarded in the amount of \$1500.00. In the event that more than one suitable candidate is selected, two or more awards may be made.

A committee will choose a candidate from all applicants, following the above criteria. Closing Date for applications is July 31th of the current year .

Masonic Higher Education Bursary Application

This Bursary is available to Canadian Citizens, resident in the town of Whitecourt, Fox Creek, Mayerthorpe, and Sangudo, and Fort Assiniboine. It is intended to assist students whose parents (or family) can give little or no support, and are unable to finance attendance in secondary institutions in Alberta. Consideration will be given to attendance at institutions elsewhere only if the course is unavailable within the Province. Preference will be given to students not qualifying for the Alexander Rutheford Sholarship.

This award is made by a committee of Whitecourt Masonic Lodge #153 whose decision is final.

The decision will be based on financial need, involvement in school, church, or community at large, 4 letters of reference (1) school principal. (2) guidance counselor.(3)teacher. (4)business person or a non related citizen reference. A short essay describing his or her future plans and why you would benefit from the scholarship.

T7S 1B6. **No later than July 31 of the current year**, to be considered for the following Academic year. Applications must be accompanied by a current High School Transcript or current record of marks.
