



## Student Apprentice Heavy Equipment Technician

### Job Specification:

Whitecourt Transport, in partnership with CAREERS, is seeking a high school student to join their team who has successfully completed Grade 11, being 17 years of age or older, to enter the Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP) in the Heavy Equipment Technician trade.

### Job Duties:

- Performs repairs and assigned preventive maintenance services.
- Performs inspection, diagnosis, and repair of electrical, hydraulic, suspension, brake and air systems on vehicles, loaders, tractors, and excavators.
- Completes required paperwork, utilizing fleet maintenance software program associated with repairing vehicles, documenting parts usage, and accounting for repair times.
- Maintains a clean, safe work area in compliance with company standards.
- Performs all work in accordance with established safety procedures.

### Special Skill Requirements:

- Preferred to have a class 5 driver's license
- Self-starter with the ability to work in a team environment
- Willing and able to learn, adapt to change and demonstrate flexibility

- Successfully completed grade 11
