Job Specification:

Job Duties:

- Working directly with their Heavy Equipment Technician or Welder
- Assisting with various jobs in the shop, working on a large variety of trucks and trailers and other equipment.
- Understand and follow company and regulatory safety regulations and work to a high level of safety
- Accountable for safe work practices applicable to the job
- Contribute towards building a strong team

Special Skill Requirements:

- Demonstrate communication (verbal and written), interpersonal and team skills
- Limited Prior Knowledge of the Trade

- Willing and able to learn, adapt to change and demonstrate flexibility
